Fanshawe Corners 1860 - 1880

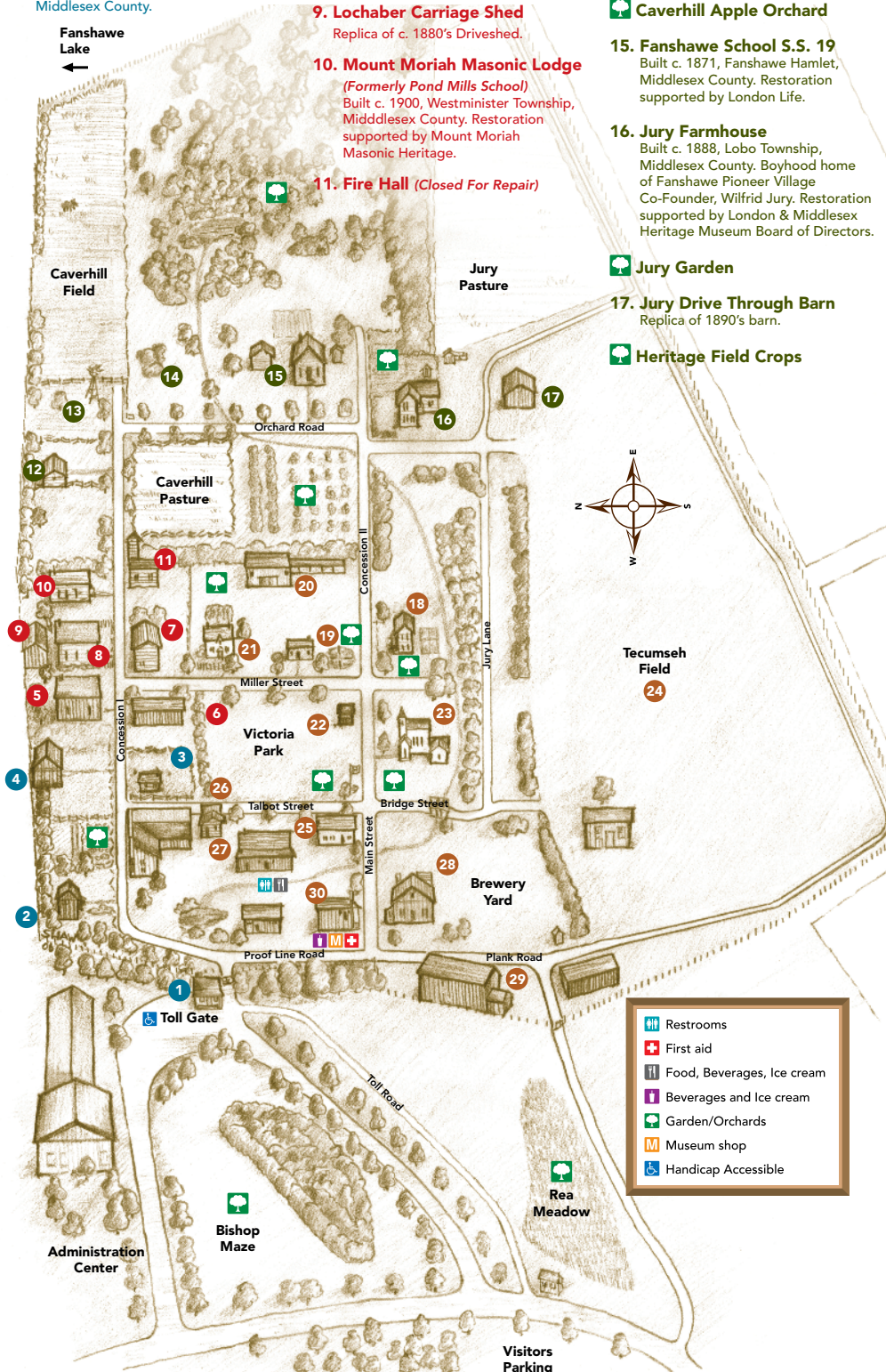
5. Purple Hill Loyal Orange Lodge No. 817

Boyhood home of artist Paul Peel. Built c. 1850, London Township, Middlesex County.

History of Agriculture Exhibition, 2nd Floor. Barn and driveshed. Built c. 1860 - 1900, London Township, Middlesex County. Restoration supported by Western Fair Association Community Enhancement Fund.

Built c. 1880, Downie Township, Perth County.
22. Lawson Gazebo
Built c. 1925, London.

Replica of 1828 London Pioneer Brewery purchased by John Labatt in 1847.

Built c. 1885, Fullarton Township, Perth County.

Built c. 1877, Denfield, Middlesex County.
